### **Eye glasses and hearing aids**

The local Lion's Club, collects used eye glasses and hearing aids which are reconditioned and given to the needy. Hearing aids are particularly important, as the ability to hear can be far more significant than the ability to see.

An old pair of prescription glasses can still be useful to indigent people in other countries, such as Mexico, Nigeria, Peru, Brazil, Poland, Romania and other countries as needed. Glass cases are not needed.

LIONS SIGHT & HEARING FOUNDATION has been recycling used glasses for twenty years. They process approximately 250,000 pair each year. These are made available to the needy in other nations through Lions In Sight and other medical mission trips.

Glasses are sorted and then shipped. Prescriptions are computerized and made available to the needy who must qualify in regards to need. Unfortunately, loose lenses (those without frames) can not be used.



Children who can see and hear will learn well in school and fulfill their potential abilities. The Foundation provides hearing aids, eyeglasses and eye surgery to correct or restore vision. It provides hearing surgery when required, usually with placement of tubes to prevent hearing loss.
