Letter Carriers Food Drive Saturday, May 10, 2008

All food donations should be non-perishable. Place your donation in a bag and place by your mailbox. These donations are picked up by volunteers, and delivered to the Sedona Food Bank.

Sign up sheets will be available at the next two Club meetings. Volunteers will meet at the Sedona Post Office at 9:30, and select a route for pick up. Volunteers in the Village of Oak Creek area will meet at (Hank: I will find out where).

There are a large number of pick-ups, so that two (2) persons per vehicle is strongly suggested. In the past, several hundred pounds of food were picked up on a single route, so that a pick-up or van is suggested. After you have finished your route, take the collected food to the storage unit on Shelby Drive, just north of the Recycle center, and south of 89A.

Old Eye Glasses Collection
