### ***RI's Goal - Total Eradication of Polio...***

Last year, more than 1,600 cases of polio were identified around the world. This is a great improvement from the worst days of polio epidemics. But it is not good enough. Rotary cannot pause or slacken our efforts. In March, RI approved a \$500,000 emergency grant to the World Health Organization to help contain the outbreak of polio in war-torn South Sudan into parts of Ethiopia, Kenya and Uganda.

The Club's Board has decided to continue the "New Years All Year Around" events this year. Proceeds from the events will help us meet our \$1,000 Polio Plus matching grant commitment to the Rotary International Foundation.
