Since 1985 Rotary has led the way to eradicate polio world-wide. Millions of people have been vaccinated, but the job is not complete. Thanks to a \$100 million challenge grant to RI by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the remaining polio-affected countries can soon be polio free. RI has accepted the challenge and asked all Clubs to raise at least \$1,000 per year for three years to match the \$100 million grant. Our Club has stepped up to the challenge by contributing to this life saving program annually. Thanks Rotarians!
